

MUNICIPAL ELECTION SCHEDULE – 2009

Cary, Pittsboro, Siler City, Goldston and Goldston Gulf Sanitary District

Filing for Municipal Offices:	Begins July 3 at noon and ends July 17 at noon (actually begins at 8 am on July 6th due to Independence Day Holiday on July 3)
Registration Deadline for Cary voters	September 11, 2009
One Stop Voting begins for Cary	September 17, 2009
One Stop Voting ends for Cary	October 3, 2009
Cary Election	October 6, 2009
Certification of Cary Election	October 13, 2009 at 11:00 am
Registration Deadline for others	October 9, 2009
One Stop Voting begins	October 15, 2009
One Stop Voting Ends	October 31, 2009
Election Day (Pittsboro, Siler City, Goldston, Goldston Gulf Sanitary District and Cary Runoff if needed)	November 3, 2009
Certification of Election	November 10, 2009 at 11:00 am

Only those voters that are registered within the incorporated boundaries of municipalities are eligible to vote in municipal elections.

Absentee by mail ballots are available 30 days before any municipal election. You can request an absentee by mail ballot by sending a request with your name, address in the municipality, Date of birth, address to mail the ballot and your signature to Chatham County Elections, PO Box 111, Pittsboro, NC 27312.
