

LWV ODC Trivia Day – March 3, 2019

Pre-competition Information

1. Doors open at 2:30 pm. Participants are encouraged to be seated as close to 3pm as possible. Trivia game begins promptly at 3:15 pm.
2. Snacks and non-alcoholic drinks will be available throughout the event.
3. Check in at the registration table, provide your team's name, and pick up your packet.
4. Teams may consist of 1 to 4 players. Individuals may join together at the event to make a team or may play individually.
5. Write your team name on each answer sheet before the beginning of the game. This will ensure that your team is identifiable once sheets are turned into the judges.
6. Assign a player to record your answers on the answer sheets.
7. Assign a player to turn your answer sheet into the judges at the end of each round.
8. Familiarize yourself with the rules.

Rules of Play

1. Have fun, and try your best! You are raising money for an amazing organization!
2. The game consists of 2 halves with 2 rounds per half, 10 questions per round, plus a possible overtime round. There will be a ten-minute half-time break.
3. In the interest of time and attention spans, each question will be read twice. If you are having trouble hearing, let the M.C. know immediately so adjustments can be made.
4. After the second reading of a question, teams will have 1 minute to write their answer.
5. No electronic devices or printed reference materials may be used during the game. No other "creative" sourcing of answers (cheating!). If you must take a call during the game, please do so outside of the trivia game area.
6. Please do not call out any answers, right or wrong. This disrupts other players.
7. Be sure to keep your team discussions at a low volume unless you want the neighboring teams to hear.
8. Correct spelling on the answer sheets is not required; however, the judges must be able to recognize your answers. Neatly print your answers and make sure they are legible and easy for the judges to read. Illegible answers will be considered incorrect.
9. Unless specified otherwise by the emcee, each question has only one correct answer. For these questions, submitting more than one answer or general descriptions will be scored as incorrect.
10. The emcee will specify if a question requires more than one answer. For these questions, the directions given by the emcee must be followed. Partial answers will be scored as incorrect.
11. Answer sheets must be turned into the judges' table during the time allowed at the end of each round. Once an answer sheet has been turned in, teams may not change their answers.
12. The judges have final say. Remember that they are merely human!
13. Correct answers will be announced by the emcee at the end of each round.
14. If you feel your team score is incorrect, notify the judges immediately.
15. In the event of a tie, a tie-breaker question between all tied teams will be used to determine the winner. One member from each tied team will be asked to represent the team. Questions will be asked until only one person answers correctly. Exciting!!
16. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place teams will win a prize. There will also be other surprises.
