3. What are two types of gerrymandering? (Note that this is referring to types, not methods or tactics.)

5. On what date was the League of Women Voters of the U.S. founded?
6. What is the legislative branch of North Carolina's government called?
Extra Point: How many state legislatures in the United States are currently unicameral?
7. NC HB 69 was filed on February 13, 2019. What is HB 69?
8. In 1960 the League of Women Voters of Chapel Hill-Carrboro (predecessor to LWVODC) established what local position in relation to education?
9. Who is Cheri Beasley?
10.
